

Title: Understanding future Landslide Hazards: March 12 earthquake, west, and March 29, 2014 landslide, east of Anjouan-Island, Comoros.

Highlight: Comoros experienced heavy rain due to tropical Cyclone Hellen in late March 2014. Land is affected (displacement in the East) in Anjouan-Island from those torrential rains, though, the hypotheses of possible further factors might be the aggravation by an early 4.8 Magnitude earthquake on 12 March in the 'West' resulting in land subsidence, cracks and risk of landslides at Mahale Village in Anjouan. The evidence of facts is that the abundance rainfall accelerated the weakness of the land in the Island.
